

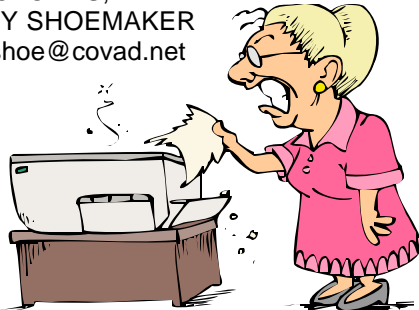

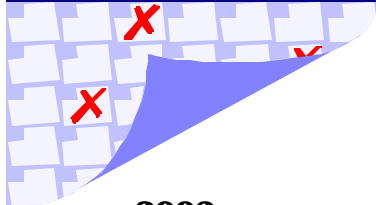

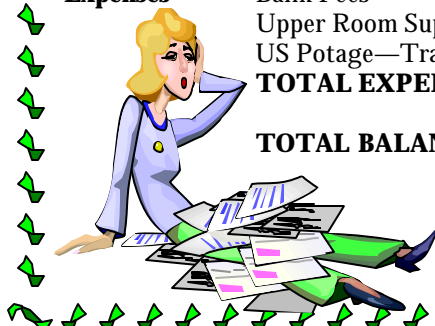
GATHERINGS

A MESSAGE FROM OUR COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

"The purpose of Emmaus is to renew the church as the body of the risen Christ in the world through development of leaders and renewal of Christians as faithful, committed disciples of Jesus Christ." (Walk to Emmaus Directors' Manual, page 7).

The purpose and objective of Emmaus is accomplished by volunteer laity and clergy who literally pay for the privilege of being in service for a weekend Walk to Emmaus. The community and the team are blessed by God to enhance the spiritual lives of Emmaus participants by encouraging one another to be active disciples and put individual gifts to work for the kingdom of God. We must always remember that Emmaus is not the Church. Emmaus is an organization designed to support member's churches through encouragement and accountability.

As members of the Emmaus community we are regularly reminded that our family and our church take priority over Emmaus and Emmaus activities. Over the past month I have had an unusual number of people tell me how much they are torn between their church's activity and an Emmaus candlelight or gathering. I always remind them, "home church comes first!"

It is not only our home church activities that have priority over Emmaus; it is also the use of our time and talents. Emmaus sponsorship and time volunteered to the Emmaus community can work in conjunction with church work. It should never replace it. The Church is the body of Christ and each person is responsible to fill their role in their church. Having met that obligation, time and talents for the Denton Area Emmaus Community are needed and appreciated.

The Walk to Emmaus helps develop and strengthen local church leaders. As you work around your church note who are candidates to sponsor on a walk. Talk to them about the purpose of Emmaus and your experience. I have seen this done as volunteers folded bulletins, placed labels on envelopes and rocked babies. Then be a good sponsor. Look around your church for Emmaus Community members - these are good candidates to fill leadership roles in your church. Encourage them to get involved to help your church ministry grow.

If your pastor has not been on a Walk to Emmaus encourage them to allow you to be their sponsor. Ask others in the Emmaus family to speak with the pastor about their experience. Surround the pastor with positive leaders while encouraging him or her to take a weekend off for their own spiritual renewal and Emmaus experience.

Sometime today, review your notes from the first talk, "Priority", and with bold confidence know you have your priority straight as you disciple the world!

THE UPPER ROOM "MODEL"

We have all heard the phrase "We've never done it that way before". Well, just because we have never done it that way doesn't mean it is wrong or won't work. We who are on the Denton Area Emmaus Board want to remind everyone the importance of following the original Walk to Emmaus model. We have heard about communities who have strayed from the model and of some of the traditions that have varied greatly from the original intent.

The "model" is actually the established set of processes and procedures affecting all aspects of the Walk to Emmaus movement, particularly the Walk itself. The Upper Room in Nashville publishes a variety of documents, manuals, and guidebooks to guide the entire Emmaus movement. The model is published in great detail in the primary Emmaus document, The Upper Room Handbook on Emmaus. What we are striving for and what the leaders of the Emmaus program in Nashville want is for the Walk experience to be the same for pilgrims attending here in Denton Area as it would be if they attended a Walk in Nashville, Los Angeles, Ohio, or any other community in the world. The best way to insure that the experience is indeed the same is by having each community follow the Emmaus model as closely as possible.

Yes, the Emmaus model is a model that works. It has worked to move Pilgrims closer to God and to encourage leadership in the local church. It has been very successful from Day 1 and all the many Fourth Days for the past 25 years. We ask for understanding and acceptance from the community as we glorify God in all things.

*You have given yourself to us, Lord. **Now we give ourselves for others.**
Your love has made us a new people. **As a people of love, we will serve you with joy.**
Your glory has filled our hearts. **Help us to glorify you in all things.**
Amen.*
