Sponsor To do list:

Prep:

1. Pray for your pilgrim every day for the way to be clear for them to go on their Walk.
2. Find out their favorite food/beverage/candy so you can bring some as agape (friends can help).
3. Collect letters from friends and loved ones

Let your Pilgrim know:

1. you will pick them up Thursday around 5:30 to leave for camp (arrive 6:00-6:30)
2. and will return Sunday before dinner time to pick them up.
3. You will pick them up the next Tuesday evening around 6:15 to go to follow-up (starts @7:00pm)
4. They only need toiletries, a flashlight and clothing (including closed toe shoes and a jacket). NOT Sheets, towel, pillow and blanket because they are provided. They are welcome to bring their own. Everything else is provided.

Bring to camp:

1. Your pilgrim
2. Letters
3. Some FOOD for the dinner table and DRINK table.
4. Your name tag (No lanyard or worship book!)
5. Other Agape (crafty gifts)

Duties at Camp: (Introduce your pilgrim at every chance)

1. Take your pilgrim to their cabin and make their bed. Give them a flashlight or have them take theirs to dinner.
2. Check your pilgrim in at the registration table.
3. Serve your pilgrim a beverage to drink as you wait for dinner to begin at 7:00.
4. After send-off attend sponsor's hour to pray over your Pilgrim's lanyard.

During their Walk:

1. Pray for your pilgrim and family. (be

fellow Emmaus friend whose name God puts on your heart. **We need these names NOW.**






